

Bandojo Song Sheet Help


Pitch (higher and lower music notes)

Music notes are represented as colored circles (filled or unfilled) with numbers inside. The colors and numbers always match each other (e.g., red is always '1'). These also match the representation of notes played on the Melody Palette. Numbers inside indicate the scale degrees.



Notes with no dots above or below signify the *middle* range.

Dots above and below notes refer to notes above and below the middle range.



NB: This is a departure from standard music notation in which the dot above and below signifies staccato (playing notes with shorter duration than normal).

Here is the full range of notes used in most of the songs.



On the Melody Palette, additional dots above and below note heads extend the range even further.
